The 2010 Wisconsin State Guernsey/Ayrshire Show will be held on **Monday July 19, 2010 9:00 a.m./ 1:00 p.m. cows show.** at the Marshfield Fairgrounds, 513 E. 17th St., Marshfield, WI. *(2010 All Wisconsin Placings will be determined by the results of the 2010 State Show, one Parish Show, and one State Fair. Tie Breakers will be determined by the highest placing animal at the State Show). All show results must be officially reported to the state office by contest entry deadline to be used toward All Wisconsin placing calculations.*

-RULES & REGULATIONS-

Participation

This show is open to all Wisconsin State Adult and Junior Members

Show Ring "Code of Ethics"

The Wisconsin State Show endorses the PDCA Code of Ethics (Rules will be posted outside of show Barn)

Cattle Check-in & Health Requirements

Facilities will be open for arrival after 6:00 p.m. on Saturday July 17th. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to notify the State Secretary (Superintendent) of the location of their animals to make certain the animals are checked in. **All animals must be checked in by 7:00 a.m. the morning of the show.** Registration papers must be available for check-in AT TIME OF ARRIVAL. Certificate of veterinary inspection is recommended but not required. There are no specific Health tests required for this show. Management has the right to decline entry to any animal exhibiting a contagious disease such as; ringworm, mange, warts etc.

Manure and bedding Disposal

Cattle will be housed on dirt flooring with concrete walkways. ONLY Shavings are allowed for bedding due to expensive removal charges. If you choose to use straw, a \$5.00 per head deposit must be made per animal. If you (the exhibitor) choose to remove all soiled straw and bedding other than shavings, your \$5.00 per head deposit will be refunded by mail. If bedding is not removed by the exhibitor, the \$5.00 per head deposit will be used to offset additional removal charges. NO ONE using straw will be permitted to show unless their \$5.00 per head fee has been paid. All shavings will be removed by show committee.

Shavings will be available for sale

Please preorder shavings if possible. Cost is approximately \$5.00 per bale. Shavings can be paid for at the fairgrounds when they are picked up.

Cattle Washing & Milk Disposal

Cattle washing must be done in designated wash racks. These are drained to sanitary sewers to comply with Wood County and City Health requirements. ***The milkhouse will be available for milking.*** Please use the milkhouse and deposit all milk (including barn milkings), in the tank unless it is contaminated. All Contaminated milk must be dumped in the city Sewer System located in the wash racks. Surface runoff of soaps, manure, milk, etc, must be prevented. (Proper Milk disposal will be enforced)

Milking Facility

A Milking facility will be available from July 17th through the show on July 19th.

Dress Code & Show Harnesses

White trousers are required. Show harnesses or other appropriate method of displaying back tag is required.

Breeding Animals

Every female over 24 months of age must have calved within 18 months or proven to be with calf or have a pregnancy from an embryo collected within 18 months.

Liabilities

Every precaution will be taken to properly protect animals in this show. Management, will not be liable for the safety of animals, exhibits, exhibitors, or their employees or for losses sustained because of robbery, damage by fire, accident, or any other cause. Exhibitors wishing to insure their livestock or exhibits must do so at their own expense.

Substitutions

Substitutions within classes with identical (farm ownership) will be permitted. No other substitutions will be allowed and all substitutions must be made no later than the time of checking registration certificates.

Dry Cow defined, Dry/Milking Class Transfer

Any cow that was fresh 280 days or more, prior to the day of the show, may be shown at the option of the exhibitor in either the Dry or Milking Cow Class. A cow milked less than 280 days must show in the Milking Class, unless she is recorded dry on the official computer report. This sheet MUST accompany animals to be shown in the Dry Cow Classes. Transfer between equivalent dry and milking classes will only be permitted with the original animal entered. Class designation must be made no later than the time of checking registration papers.

Ownership

Animals must be entered exactly as ownership appears on the registration certificate. The registration certificate showing the most recent activity will be considered official.

Registration Certificate / Group Classes

All animals exhibited must be registered. A Registered animal is defined by the American Guernsey Breeders Assn. as any animal designated as GR or above. No animals other than GR's being upgraded through the Genetic Recovery program, or fully registered animals will be allowed to show. Registration Certificates for all animals entered in any group class must be brought into the ring with the animals. Failure to present the registration certificates for any animals entered in a group will automatically disqualify the group.

Premier Breeder

The exhibitor winning the most points on not to exceed 6 animals, in the open single classes exhibited by themselves and or other exhibitors, shall be designated Premier Breeder.

Premier Exhibitor / Junior Exhibitor (same... except not to exceed 3 Head)

The exhibitor winning the most points on not to exceed six animals, which he/she owns and exhibits in the open single classes, shall be designated the Premier Exhibitor.

Rules for Junior-Owned Animals

The State Junior Show will be held at the same time as the Open Show. Juniors will be recognized, placed, and awarded ribbons by stepping forward in their respective Open Show classes. The Wisconsin Guernsey Breeders will provide ribbons in each class of the Junior Division. Production Awards will be given to the Highest production of milk, butterfat, and Protein. In each milking cow class Junior Three-Year-Old and Older.

Eligibility:

Participation in the show is open to all young men and women who are recorded owners of one or more registered Guernsey females, properly recorded in the Herd register of the American Guernsey Association or respective National Guernsey Association or participate in the American Guernsey Association Youth Lease Agreement Program. Junior Exhibitors must have been born after January 1, 1989

Ownership:

In all classes the recorded ownership must show in the sole ownership of the exhibitor or partnership comprised of only junior members or a participant in the American Guernsey Association Youth Lease Agreement Program. The qualifying record of ownership or lease for animals, other than those bred by the junior exhibitor, shall be determined by the actual date the application for transfer of ownership was received in the offices of the American Guernsey Association. This date is automatically stamped on the back of the registration certificate and will be found with the transfer of ownership data. The latest qualifying transfer date is July 1, 2010.

If the participant is exhibiting under the American Guernsey Association Youth Lease Agreement Program, all guidelines and terms must have been followed and a copy of the signed and dated agreement must be present at Check in.

Exhibitors may participate in as many years as his or her eligibility will permit. Each eligible exhibitor is limited to one entry in any one class but may show in each class. There is no limitation on the number of times an eligible animal may be exhibited. Exhibitors are required to show their own animals except that a substitute showman who meets the age requirements may be used in case the owner, for some justifiable reason, is unable to attend the show. Adults are not allowed to show in any case.
